You can bring your own things to make the flat the way you would like it.



There is a garden that you can use when you want to.



At Northgate there is a special room called a sensory room where you can go to relax.



There is also an activities room where you can play computer games, table tennis or do art/crafts and table top activities.



At the sports centre you can play football or tennis and you can try snooker and bowling.



There is a shop at Northgate.



You can go to the shop to buy sweets and other nice things.
