A physiotherapist can help you with your **posture** and your **movement**.



Posture

We will look at protecting your posture which may involve referral for specialist equipment including wheelchairs, seating, orthotics and sleep systems.



Movement/function

A physiotherapist can help improve movement and function. They may give you advice and exercises. They may also provide you with a walking aid.



We may recommend specific treatment sessions such as hydrotherapy.

We will advise and support your carers to assist you in your everyday life.



We may also work with other health care professionals such as community nurses or speech and language therapists. This is so we can all work together to support you in the best way.



We may work with you at home or in the community e.g. at colleges and/or day centres.


